**Preparation** 

1. Ensure all surfaces are clean, dry, firm and free from dust, dirt, oil, grease or other foreign matter.

2. Friable surfaces must be cleaned and degreased.

3. Areas beside a joint should be masked with tape for a neat finish and removed immediately after tooling.

**Application** 

 Cut the dome of the cartridge with a sharp knife, taking care not to damage the thread, pierce the foil membrane, then screw the nozzle on and insert into a cartridge gun.

Extrude sealant into the joint ensuring complete contact with both surfaces.

3. Smooth the sealant with a knife within 5 minutes of application.
