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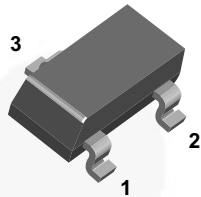


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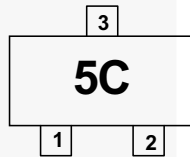

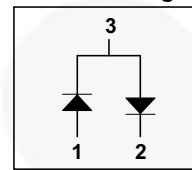

Absolute Maximum Ratings^{(1), (2)}

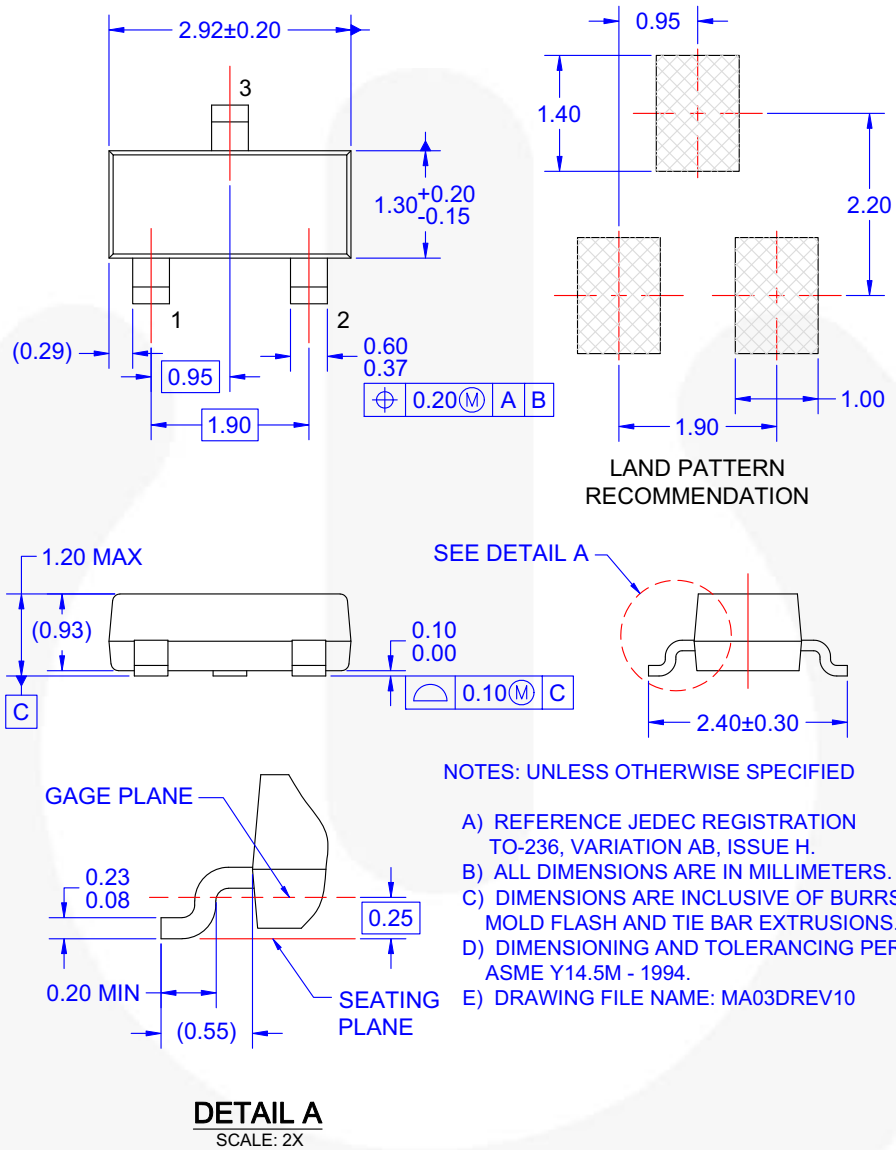







Figure 1. 3-LEAD, SOT23, JEDEC TO-236, LOW PROFILE



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
