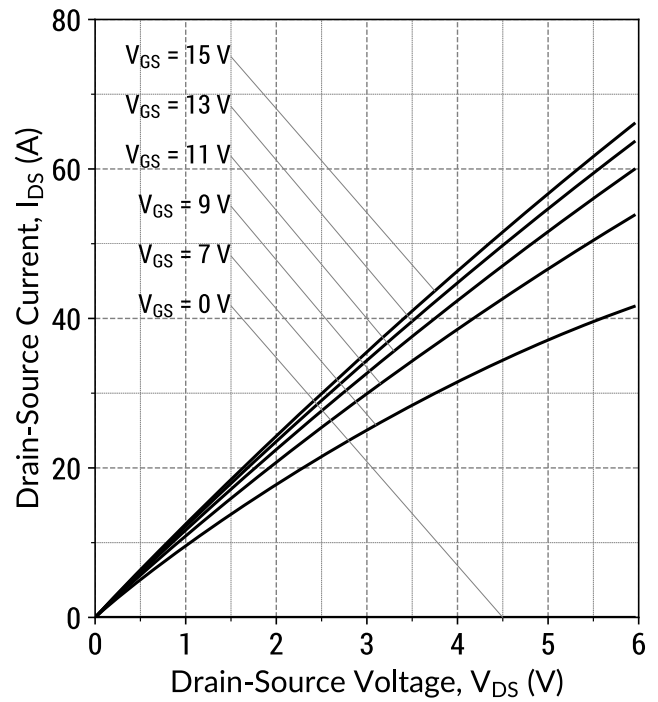

Figure 1: Output Characteristics ($T_j = 25^\circ\text{C}$)



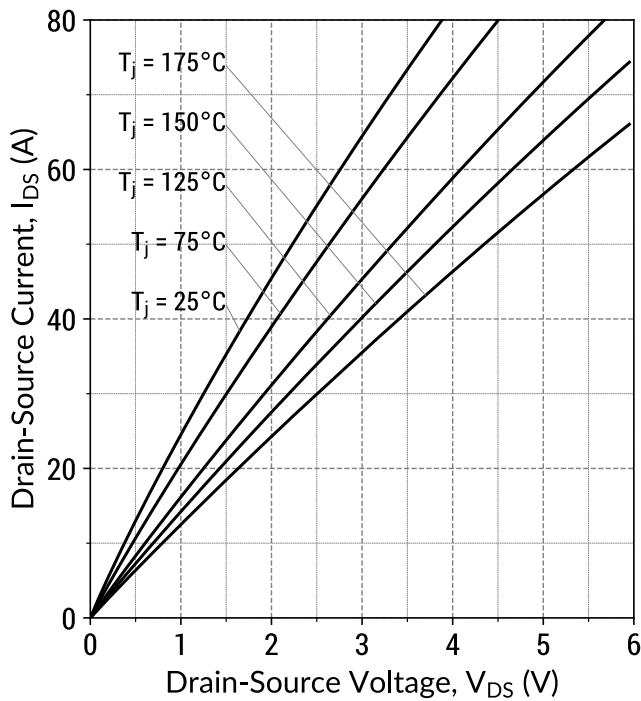

Figure 2: Output Characteristics ($T_j = 175^\circ\text{C}$)



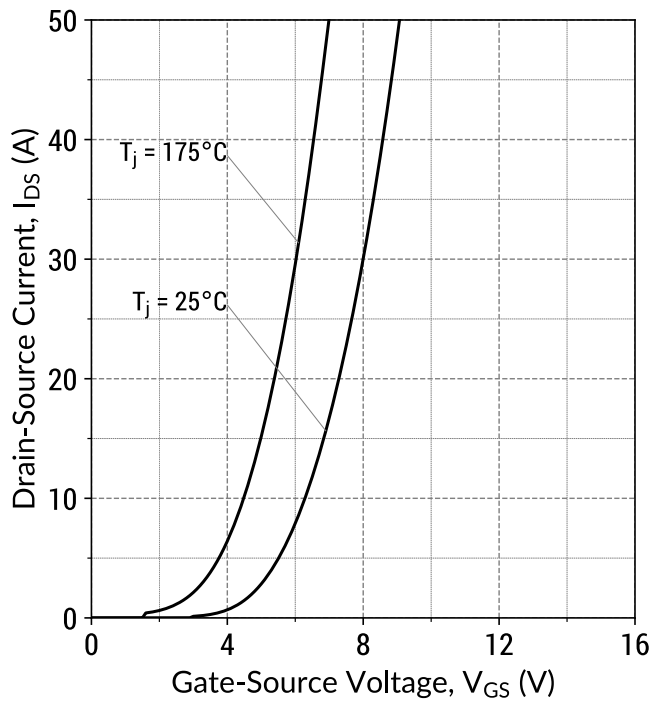

Figure 3: Output Characteristics ($V_{GS} = 15 \text{ V}$)



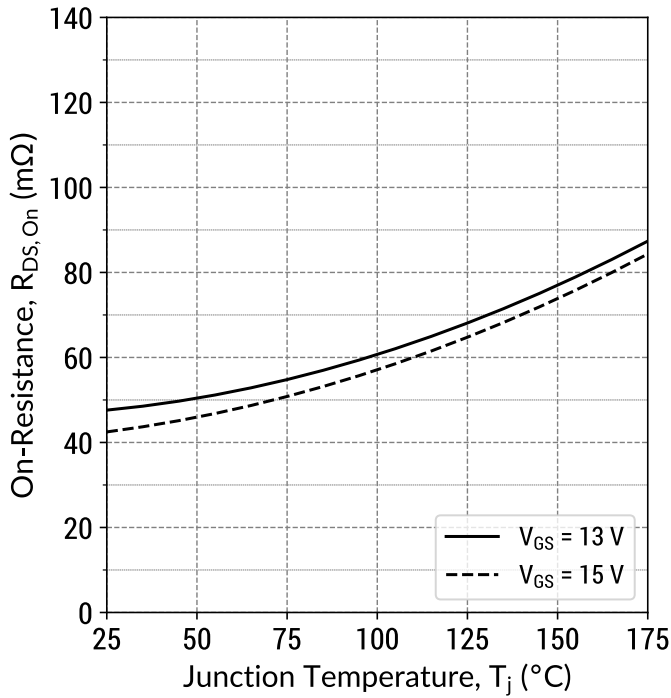

Figure 4: Transfer Characteristics ($V_{DS} = 10 \text{ V}$)



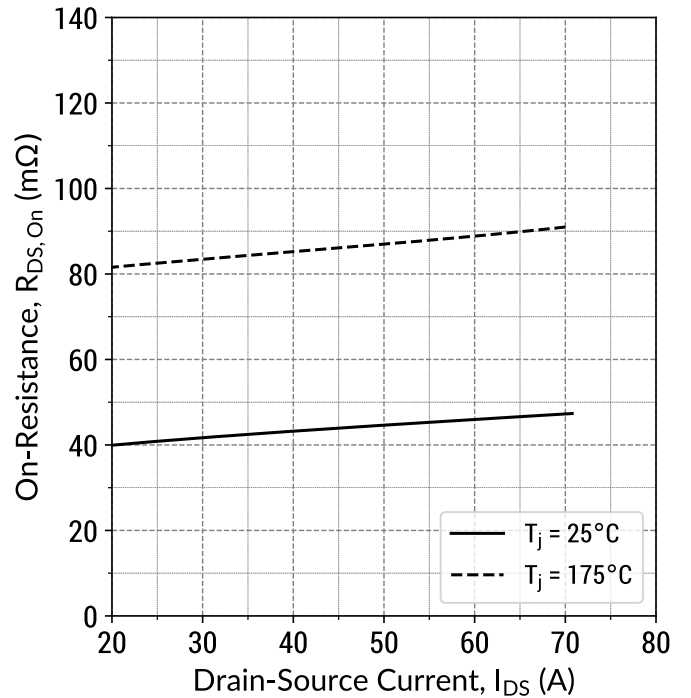

Figure 5: On-State Resistance v/s Temperature



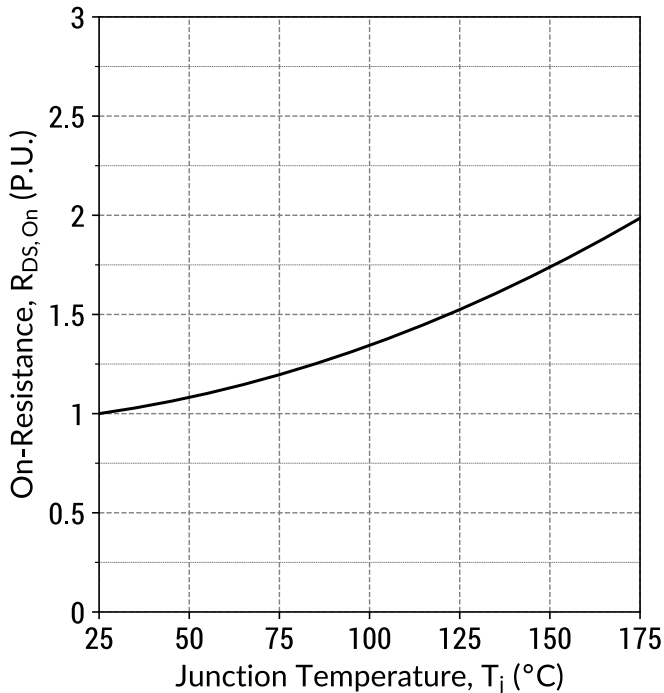

Figure 6: On-State Resistance v/s Drain Current



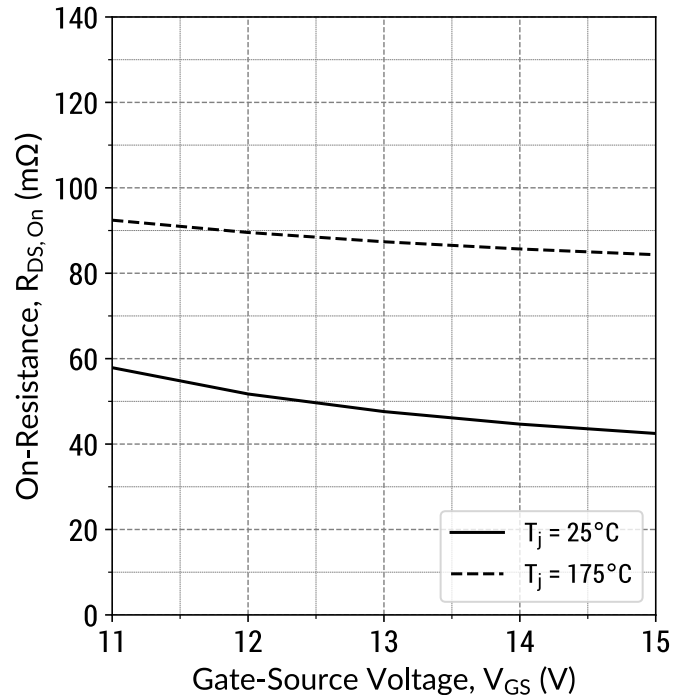

Figure 7: Normalized On-State Resistance v/s Temperature



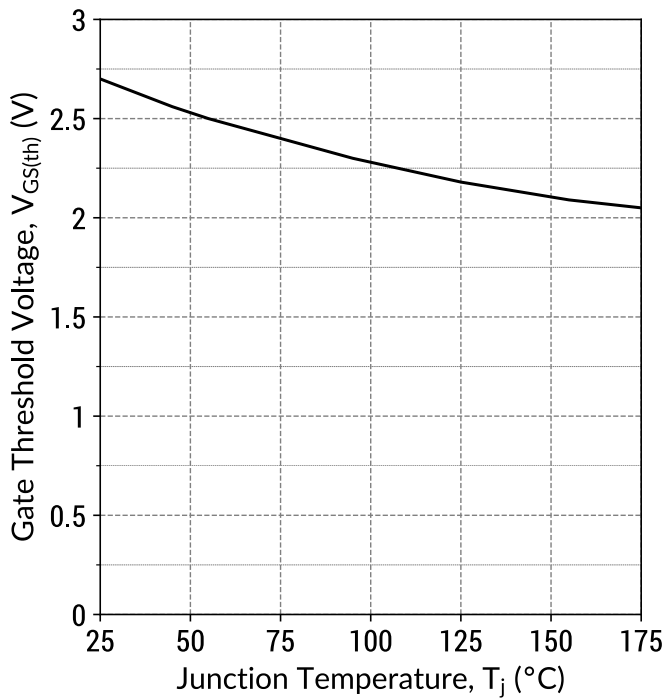

Figure 8: On-State Resistance v/s Gate Voltage



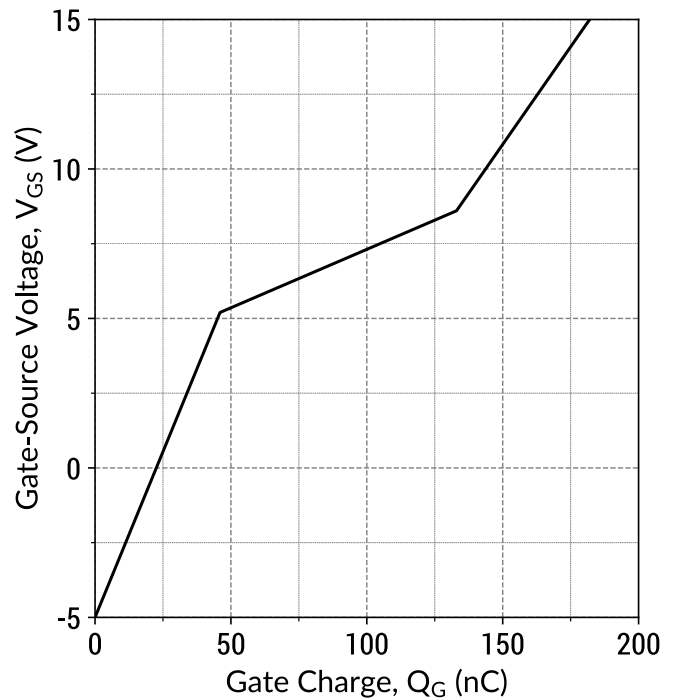

Figure 9: Threshold Voltage Characteristics



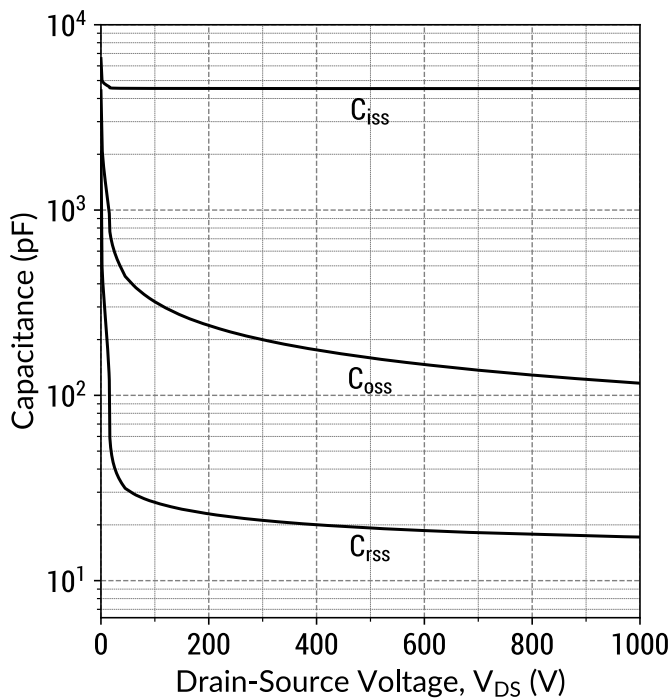

Figure 10: Gate Charge Characteristics



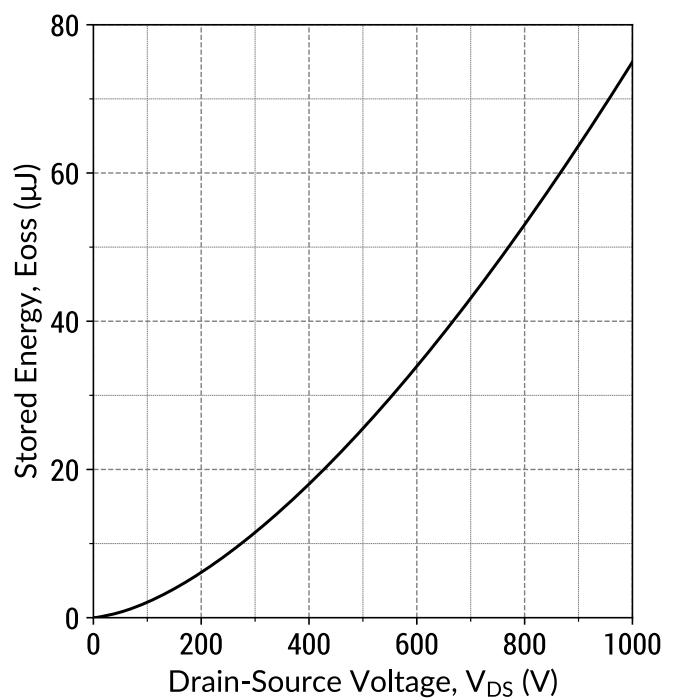

Figure 11: Capacitance v/s Drain-Source Voltage



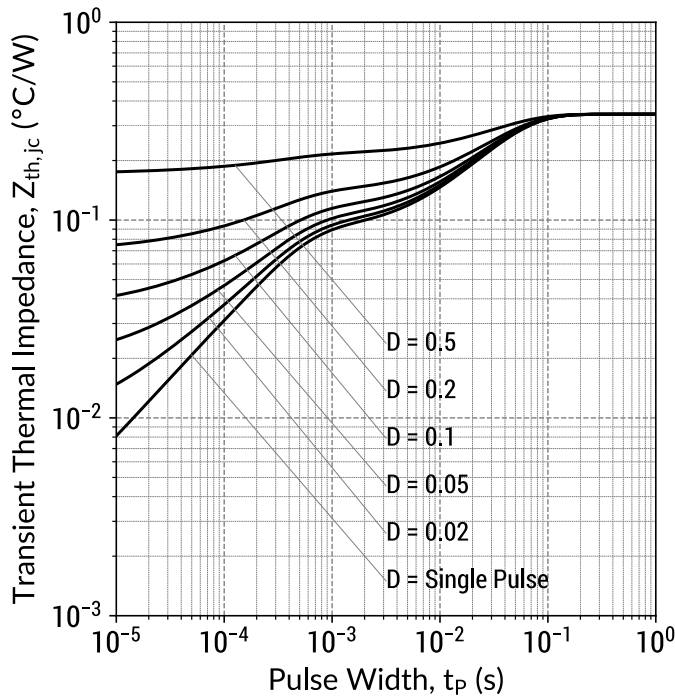

Figure 12: Output Capacitor Stored Energy



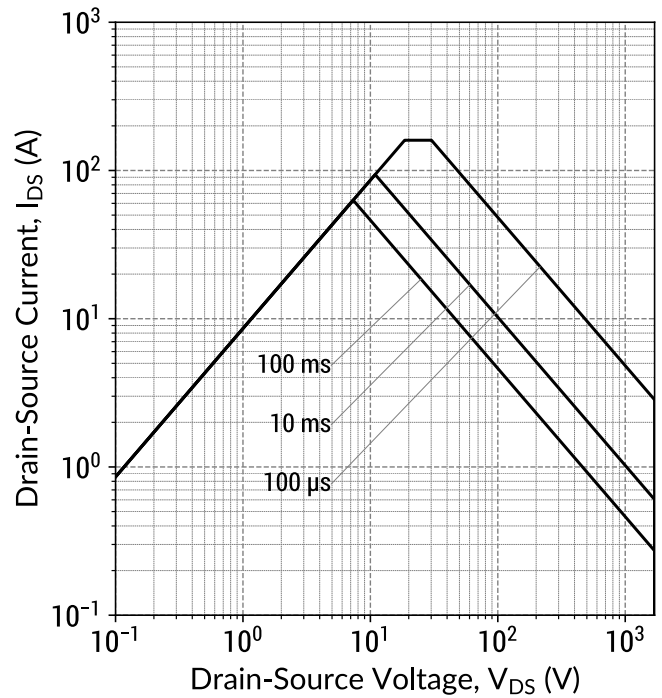

Figure 13: Transient Thermal Impedance



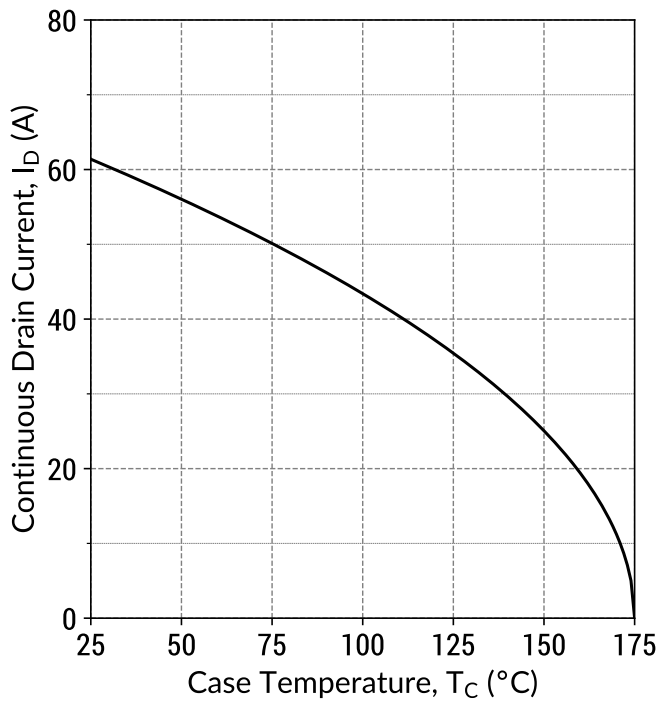

Figure 14: Safe Operating Area ($T_c = 25^\circ\text{C}$)



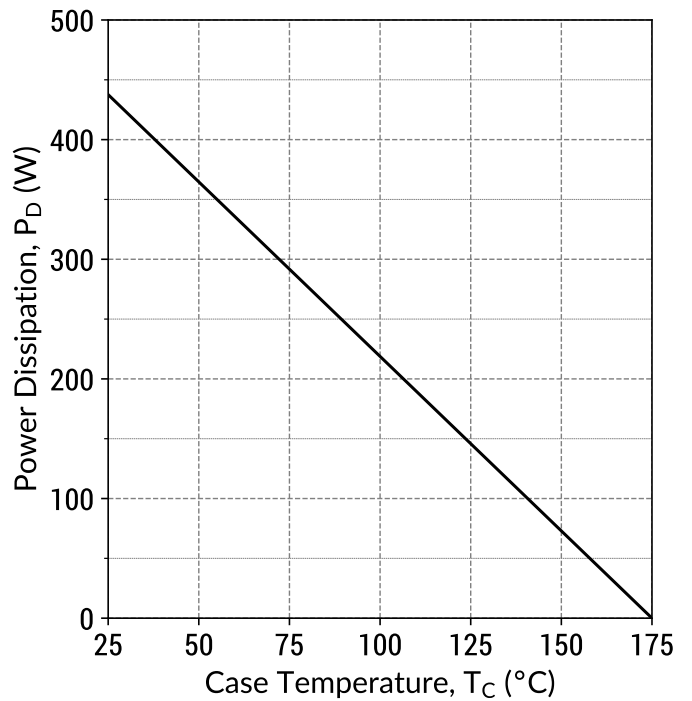

Figure 15: Current De-rating Curve



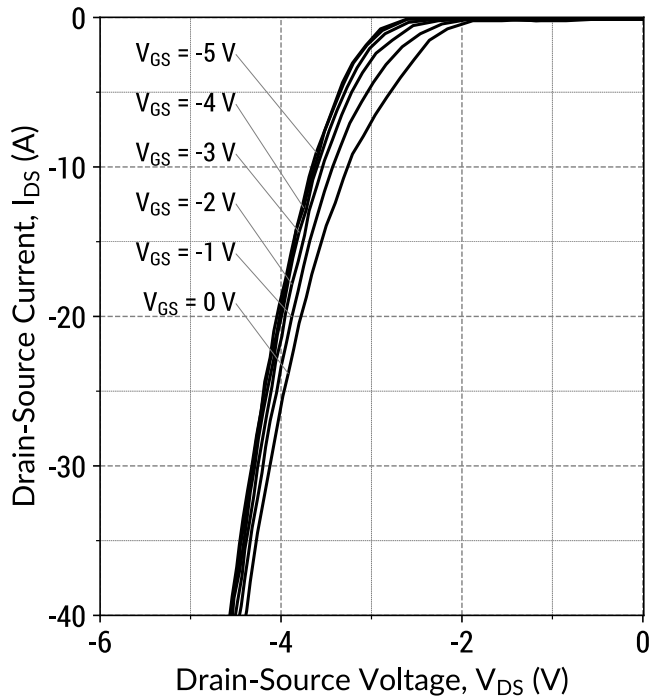

Figure 16: Power De-rating Curve



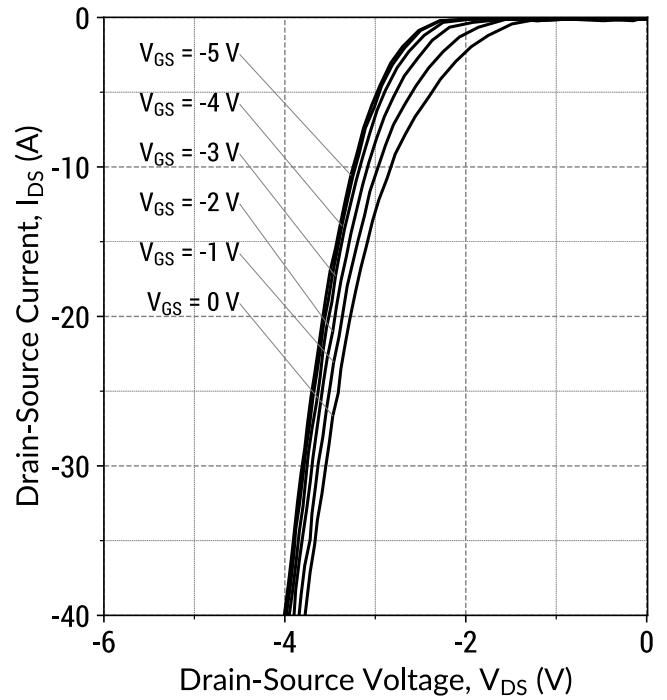

Figure 17: Body Diode Characteristics ($T_j = 25^\circ\text{C}$)



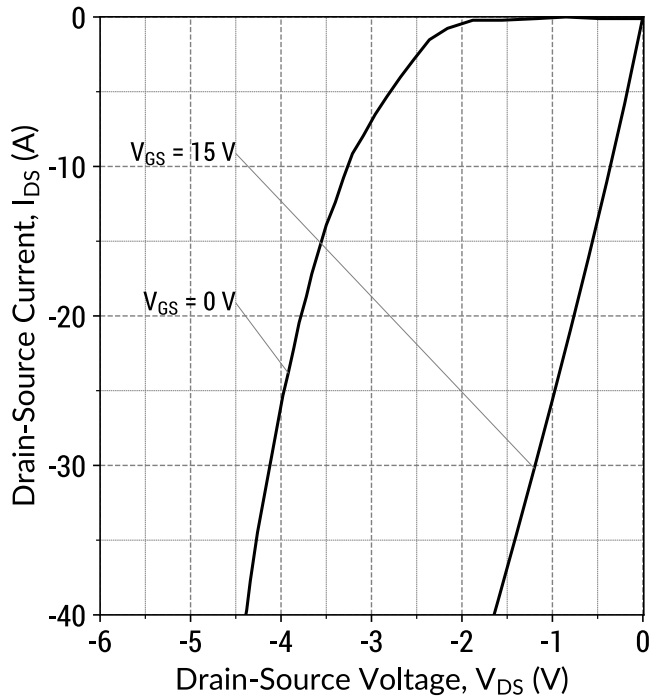

Figure 18: Body Diode Characteristics ($T_j = 175^\circ\text{C}$)



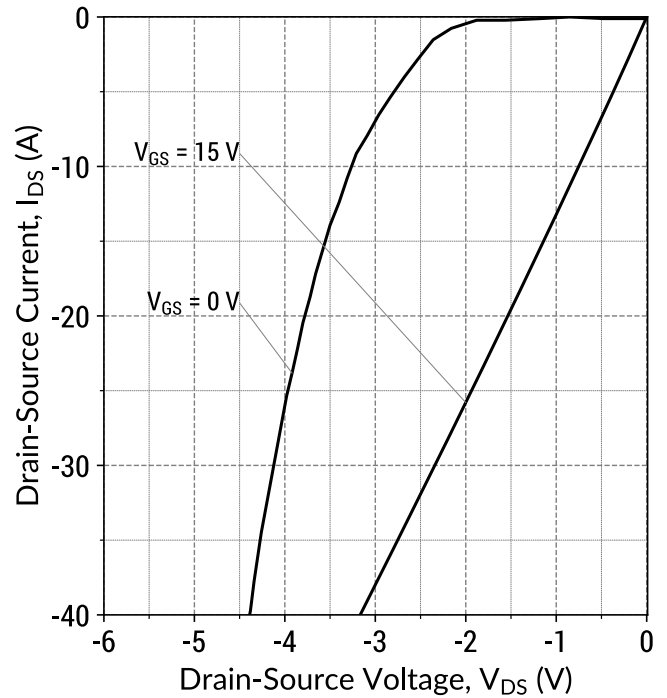

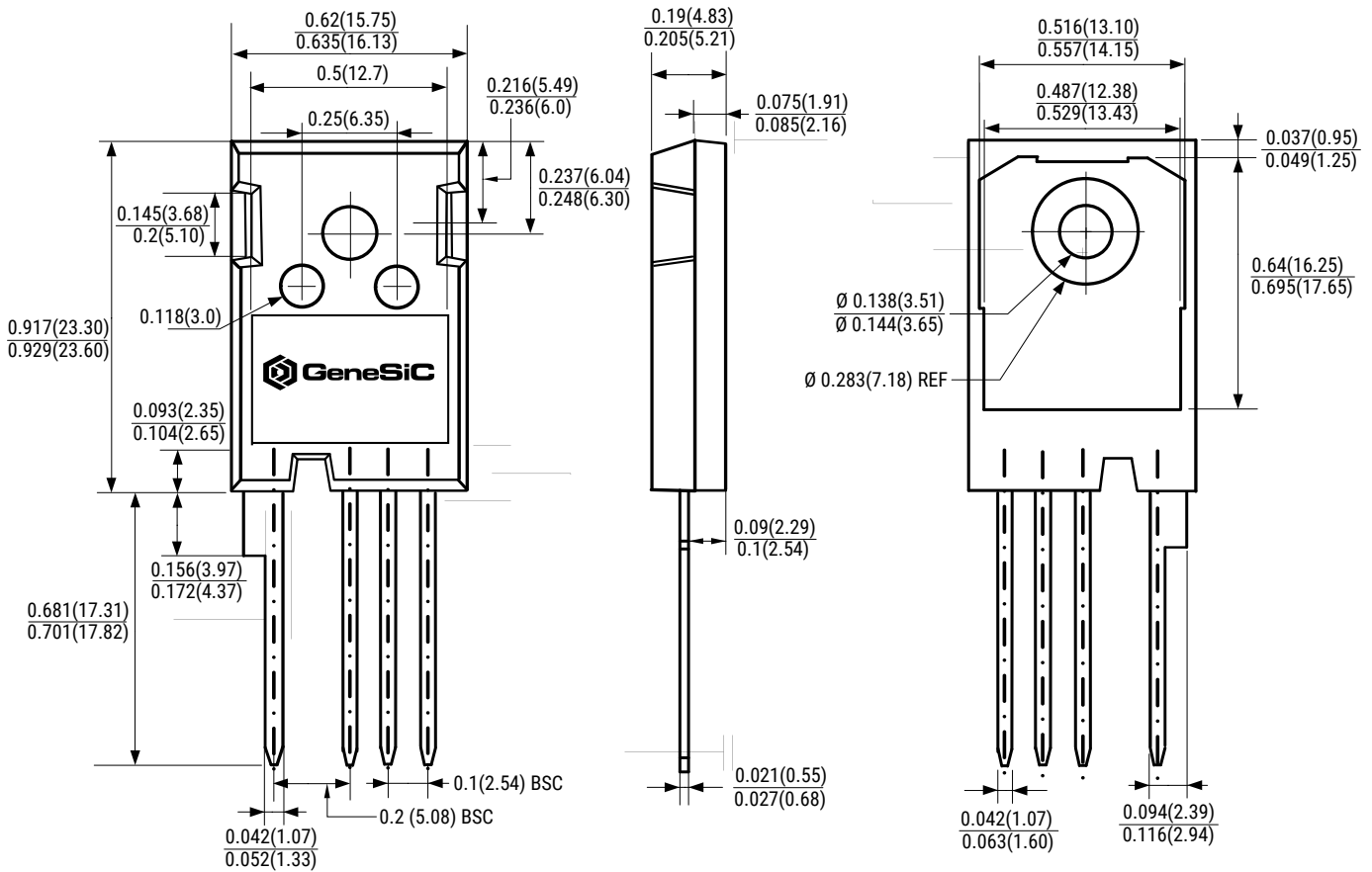
Figure 20: Third Quadrant Characteristics ($T_j = 175^\circ\text{C}$)



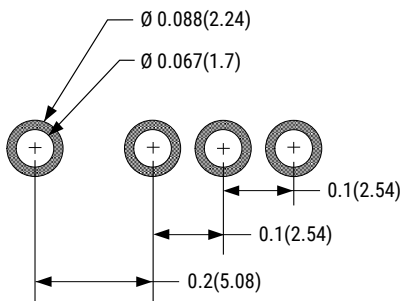

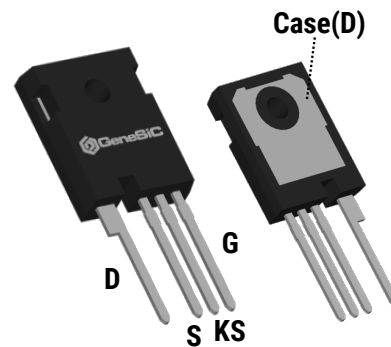
