






(1) IN (BASE)(2) GND (+) (EMITTER)(3) OUT (COLLECTOR)



Fig.2 Output current vs. input voltage (OFF characteristics)




Fig.3 Output current vs. output voltage






Fig.4 DC current gain vs. output current



DC CURRENT GAIN : G





Precaution for Electrostatic

Please take special care under dry condition (e.g. Grounding of human body / equipment / solder iron, isolation from charged objects, setting of lonizer, friction prevention and temperature / humidity control).

Precaution for Storage / Transportation
