




### **Output Characteristics**




### Transconductance






### On-Resistance vs. Drain Current









On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature




Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage



On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage




Threshold Voltage




**Drain Source Breakdown vs. Junction Temperature**


Safe Operating Area

The latter is valid for the part mounted on printed circuit board - FR4, size 1" x 1" x 0.062", double sided with 2 oz. copper, 100 % on both sides. The part capabilities can widely vary depending on actual application parameters and operating conditions

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
