



# The convenient way to keep in touch with your lifestyle

Being out of your home or your office doesn't have to mean being out of touch. British Telecom's Wren answering machine will record incoming calls while you're away from your phone, whether you're out and about or simply in the bath!

Wren's incredibly easy to use, too. A single micro-cassette records both your outgoing message and the incoming calls. And you operate it with exactly the same controls you'll be familiar with from your cassette recorder: play, pause, rewind and fast forward. Your outgoing message can be up to two minutes long, so you can leave a detailed message if you want (where you'll be during the day, for example). And, to help make sure you don't miss a single recorded message, there's even a display on Wren which shows you how many calls have been taken.

## Check who's calling before you decide to answer

Wren lets you screen calls before you pick up the receiver. When you're at home you can leave Wren switched to answer mode and you'll hear your callers leaving their messages through Wren's built-in speaker. If you want to speak to the caller you simply pick up your phone. If you don't, just let Wren carry on recording the message.

What's more, after Wren has answered a call, you can interrupt it from any extension phone, in your bedroom, for instance. So if you don't answer the call before Wren, you're able to take over the call if you so wish.



## Listen to your messages from anywhere in the world

With Wren, you don't have to go home to find out who's called you. You can listen to your recorded messages from any phone, anywhere in the world! You simply activate Wren's playback function with your voice by going through a simple procedure. That means even if you're on holiday, or simply delayed at a meeting, you can still act on the messages before it's too late.

For extra security, you can set Wren to play back your messages only when it receives a special code. You can send the code using the keypad of any *TouchTone*<sup>®</sup> phone (or from any other phone by using the British Telecom Remote Interrogator<sup>†</sup>). And if you leave home and forget to turn on your Wren, you can do that from any phone. All you have to do is call your own number and let it ring twenty times. Easy!

## Leave a recorded message for your family or colleagues

If you're going out and you want to leave a message for your family ('Your dinner's in the oven' 'I'll be back at eight' 'Can you empty the washer?') you can use Wren to record your message. So you don't need a pencil or paper.

And, naturally, Wren's display tells your family that there's a message waiting for them. Available from high street shops, Wren can be bought at a price that every home or small business can afford.
