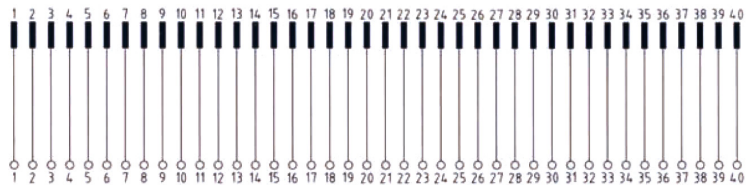
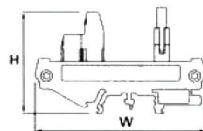
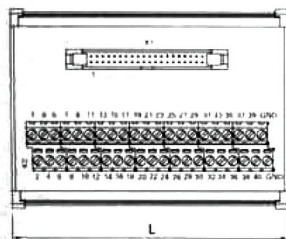


Description
