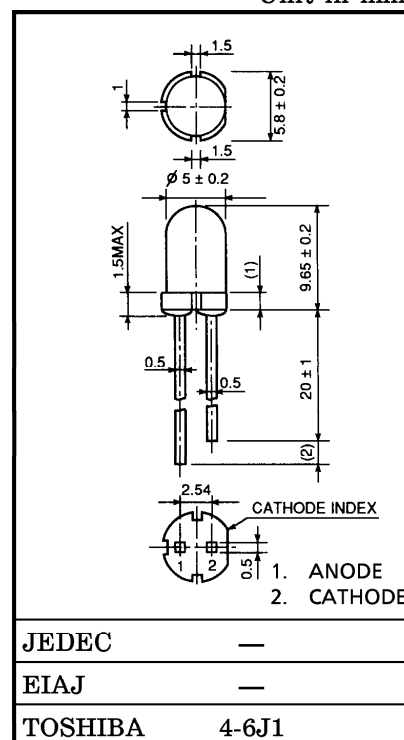

PRECAUTION

Please be careful of the followings

- Soldering temperature : 260°C MAX. Soldering time : 3s MAX.
(Soldering portion of lead : up to 2mm from the body of the device)
- If the lead is formed, the lead should be formed up to 5mm from the body of the device without forming stress to the resin. Soldering should be performed after lead forming.
