## PRODUCT DATA SHEET

<b>Product</b>	<b>Black Stove and Grate Polish</b>
<b>Type</b>	Matt black water-based polish.
<b>Intended Use</b>	For use on wood/coal stoves, grates and surrounds.
<b>Special Features</b>	It is particularly useful for covering minor rust spots, scratches or paint chips.
<b>Preparation</b>	Ensure stove is either cold or at least moderately warm, protect surrounding soft furnishings or carpets, as graphite can stain if contact occurs.
<b>Application</b>	Apply sparingly with a dampened soft cloth and then polished off with a dry cloth or soft brush into a rich matt black finish. Re-apply sparingly once area is clean and dry.
<b>Coats</b>	Aa required.
<b>Drying Time</b>	Immediately.
<b>Re-coating Time</b>	Re-apply when required.
<b>Application Temp.</b>	Cold ideally but can be moderately warm.
<b>Coverage</b>	5 – 10 sq. metres per lite depending on nature of the surface.
<b>Maintenance</b>	Re-apply when required.
<b>Compatibility</b>	Use on cast iron articles, otherwise conduct a small compatibility test as necessary.
<b>Settlement</b>	Stir well before use.
<b>Shelf-life/Storage</b>	2 years if stored unopened in a cool, dry place. After using add a few drops of water to the tin and close lid tightly to prevent drying out.
<b>Hazards</b>	Harmful, flammable. Keep out of reach of children. For further information, download SDS from <a href="http://www.rustinsltd/hotspot">www.rustinsltd/hotspot</a> or contact directly.
<b>Clean-Up</b>	Rub off excess and wash hands with warm soapy water.
<b>Sizes</b>	170g tin or 75ml tube
