Product DescriptionGorilla Super Glue is a cyanoacrylate adhesive for instant repairs on smaller, indoor

projects. It is very fast, sets in under a minute, with no clamping required. After I-5 min. you can make a light handling of the project. Gorilla Super Glue has Impact-Tough

Formula, which makes a bond that's impact-resistant. This helps your project resist bump,

bangs and drops.

Gorilla Super Glue can typically be exposed to temperatures ranging from -55° to 100° C.

Too much exposure to water, especially warm water, can compromise the strength of the

bond.

Application Gorilla Super Glue can be used on wood, metal, stone, ceramics, plastic, PVC sheet, brick,

paper and rubber. Before gluing, clean the surfaces of your project to rid of dirt, dust and grease. Apply a small amount of Gorilla Super Glue, put your pieces together and hold for

15-60 seconds.

Gorilla Super Glue activates by moisture on the pieces and it does not foam during set up.

Cleaning from skin and project Soak bonded area with warm soapy water or acetone and let it penetrate the bond. After

soaking the adhesive should come off easily.



Storage Gorilla Super Glue must be stored in tightly sealed packaging with no risk of moisture

reaching the adhesive. Storage: Avoid direct sunlight, temperature 5° to max. 25° C.

Shelf lifeThe adhesive has a minimum shelf life on I year from the production date.

Safety precautions The Safety Data Sheet for Gorilla Super Glue should be observed thoroughly before start

of using the adhesive.
